Prayer and Reflection

- How did God speak to me today? What's one way I can apply that to my life this next week? Who will I share this with?

- What sin(s) do I need the Stronger Man to free me from?

- Ask God how you can be Courageously Hopeful, Prudently Wise, Outwardly Focused, and Prayerfully Spreading the Gospel.

Discussion Ideas:

1. What stuck out to you from this passage? Any questions you have or parts you don't understand?
2. What did this passage teach you about God's character, actions, or will?
3. What are you doing to intentionally know, hear, and obey God's Word? If nothing, making an intentional plan this week. (A couple ideas: 1. Study the passage of Scripture Eric is preaching on BEFORE Sunday. 2. Pick a book of the Bible and study it, writing down what you see the passage says, what it means, and how you can apply it to your life for each section. 3. Talk with someone to help you develop a plan.)
4. Who are you talking with about what you're learning about God and encouraging to live like Jesus in your words and actions (a Disciple-Making Friendship)? If no one, who could you?
5. Why is it tempting to put more emphasis into learning more about God than obeying what we already know (recognizing the importance and necessity of both)?
